

Emerald Valley Women's Golf Club

Annual Tournaments – the handicapped events have payouts at the end of the the season, and we encourage all members to participate. Members are never required to play in the tournaments. Please notify the tournament organizers if you choose to opt-out. Regular stroke play will take place for non-participants.

Medal Tournament

This is a three-round tournament that counts the 2 best net scores. The three rounds do not need to be played in consecutive weeks. The lowest score wins.

Handicap Tournament

This is a Match Play tournament played in three-rounds. Each hole is worth a point. If tied each player gets ½ point. This tournament is handicapped. First round matches are determined by matching players with those closest to their own handicap. Second and third round matches pair those with the closest amount of points. The pairings may be adjusted so that no one plays the same person twice. Most points wins.

Partner Best Ball

Any two members can be partners. If there is more than 8-strokes difference in the handicaps between the 2-players, the higher handicap will be adjusted down. This is a net score tournament. The lowest score wins.

Women's Club Championship

This is a two-round handicapped tournament. There are several winning categories. Medalist winner is the person with the lowest score on the first day of play. A net winner is awarded to the lowest combined net score. Women's Club Champion is the lowest gross score winner.

Invitational

This tournament is a celebration of fun summer golf. We encourage our members to invite their friends to join us for a theme-based day of golf that includes prizes, a luncheon and often a raffle and/or silent auction. A handicap is not required to play in the Invitational.
